

NOTICE TO COLUMBIA STATE STUDENTS WITH FALL 2021 SEMESTER CLASSES BEGINNING THE WEEK OF AUGUST 23.

SHOULD STUDENTS REPORT TO CAMPUS THE WEEK OF AUGUST 23?

The answer to that question will depend on the type of class. Most classes will not meet on campus during the first week.

TYPES OF COURSES OFFERED

The Fall 2021 course schedule includes several instructional formats. Attributes in the right-most column of the course schedule help define the type of course.

Select the box in front of the CRN (C identifies a closed class; NR indicates no registration currently available) and choose Register or Add to Worksheet. To determine the actual location (Columbia, Franklin, Lawrenceburg, etc.) of a class or if it is taught or delivered using an alternative method (internet, hybrid, interactive video, etc.), please click on the CRN number! Alternative delivery is also identified in the attribute column. You may also click on the link that opens a new window to view definitions for alternative delivery and a legend for identifying section locations, schedule coding schemes, etc.

The following definitions of the attributes define whether or not you should be on campus during the first class meeting.

- In Person** – A few classes will have all course meetings on campus and will meet during the first week of the term. These classes are identified by the attribute of In Person and will not have the Live Streaming via Zoom attribute. Students should attend at the location provided in the schedule or by the instructor/program director sent via Columbia State email if complete information is not available in the schedule.
- In Person and Live Streaming via Zoom** - These courses will show in the schedule with required meeting days, times, and a meeting location. These courses will meet via Zoom during the 1st week of the term. Use the instructions below to check for an announcement in Online Campus for the Zoom link to attend class the first week. If your class does not have an Online Campus presence then check your Columbia State email for an email from your instructor with the link for live streaming. Students will be required to attend some class meetings on campus. During the first week of classes, instructors will inform students which specific class days to participate in person. Students must be able to be on campus on the days and times assigned and must also be able to participate in classes via Zoom for all other class meetings. Throughout the semester, students should check Online Campus announcements and Columbia State emails for

any changes of in-person meeting requirements in the event of a COVID quarantine for the entire class. Students need a computer with a camera and microphone for best participation in Zoom sessions. Earbuds will be needed if participating from campus in a space used by multiple students.

Instructions to check for Zoom link in Online Campus:

On the first day of class, log in to Online Campus by going to www.ColumbiaState.edu and clicking on :

Click on the name of the class that you are trying to attend such as :

You should see announcements such as:

Click on the Zoom link that is shown in your course information in Online Campus a few minutes before the time for your class to start. Some faculty use a waiting room feature of Zoom and will not allow students into the room until the faculty member has entered the Zoom room. You may need to wait a few minutes after the class start time on the first day of class before gaining access to the room. Faculty will understand if you have trouble logging into the Zoom classroom the first day, but this should not become a habit.

- **Live Streaming via Zoom** classes are engaged live virtual learning. Students will participate in class during the scheduled days and times for lecture using links to Zoom classrooms and will submit assignments using Online Campus or other software specific to the course. Students need a computer with a camera and microphone for best participation in Zoom sessions. Earbuds will be needed if participating from campus in a space used by multiple students. Students are not required to be on campus to participate in live-streaming sessions. On the first day of class, log in to Online Campus by going to www.ColumbiaState.edu

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- **Internet Online Course** - Students set their schedule for completing the class (asynchronous) and do not have to log in at a certain time or day. - **TN eCampus** – Students set their schedule for completing the class (asynchronous) and do not have to log in at a certain time or day. Students are required to meet all published assignment deadlines in order to pass the course. During the first week of class log in to Online Campus by

going to www.ColumbiaState.edu and clicking on :



Follow instructions on this screen to determine your username and password to the TNeCampus system. It will not be the same as your Columbia State PVT account. During the first day of class there is typically an announcement on this page to inform students when they should be able to log in to the system.
