## **Columbia State Online Campus:**

- 1. Section Numbers: Begin with "C"; for example: ENG-1010-C91
- 2. **Tuition & Fees**: Typically less expensive than TNeCampus classes. (Other fees may apply). <u>Visit the Columbia State</u> <u>Tuition and Fees page</u>.
- 3. Refund & Withdrawal Deadlines: Visit the Academic Calendar page
- 4. Classes: Taught by Columbia State instructors. Available the morning of the first day of class.
- 5. **Textbooks**: <u>Visit the Columbia State Bookstore</u> to determine which textbooks and resources are needed.
- 6. Login and Access: Visit the Columbia State homepage to login. Use your ChargerNet credentials.
- 7. Attendance Reporting: Columbia State instructors confirm and report student attendance.

## **TN eCampus Classes:**

- 1. Section Numbers: Sections numbers begin with "R". For example: ENGL-1010-R50.
- Tuition & Fees: Typically have an additional per credit hour fee. (Other fees may apply). Visit the TNeCampus Tuition and Fees page.
- 3. Refund & Withdrawal Deadlines: Visit the Academic Calendar page.
- 4. Classes: Taught by instructors at universities and colleges across the state, including Columbia State.
- 5. Textbooks: Visit the TN eCampus Virtual Bookstore to determine which textbooks and resources are needed.
- 6. Login and Access: <u>Visit the TN eCampus student portal</u> and use your unique TN eCampus credentials. These are NOT your ChargerNet credentials.
- 7. Attendance Reporting: TN eCampus attendance is reported via the automated Student Participation survey. You must complete a survey FOR EACH COURSE.
