SEPTEMBER 15 - OCTOBER 17

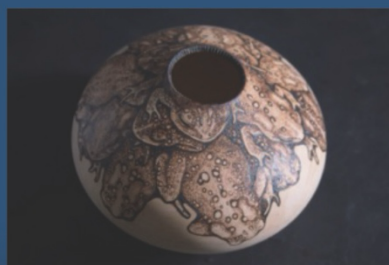

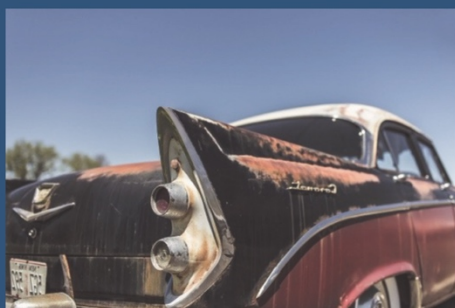
COLUMBIA STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE Works by Students, Faculty & Staff FEBRUARY 23 - MARCH 13
